

# JEB DUNNUCK

## **2018 Chateau De Pressac (92-94+)**

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Aging in 50% new barrels, the 2018 Château De Pressac checks in as a blend of 70% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc, and the rest Cabernet Sauvignon. It has a ripe, powerful, yet reserved style in its cassis and black raspberry fruit yet offers up more chocolate, tobacco, and minerality with time in the glass. Deep, full-bodied, and concentrated, it has beautiful balance, ripe tannins, and a great finish. I suspect short-term cellaring will be the way to go, but it's a beautiful, serious Saint-Émilion that's going to keep for two decades.
