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St emilion grand cru classé, 2021: older vintages

Winner of the most complex assemblage in the appellation, featuring all five planted varieties including Pressac (Malbec) which is named for the property, the 2016 Château de Pressac (it vineyards, with the Carmenère turning golden red in Autumn, pictured below) offered an array of dark and elegantly framed fruit, with attractive density and concentration.
